Has good functionality. A lot of support from Library staff, bookable workshops and Library guides available	New refWorks is not yet supported by UoA as it does not contain all required features. Large number of citation styles and allows for sharing references with groups. Reference details can be accessed from any computer with an internet connection	Easy to use. It has a function for highlighting text in PDFs and adding comments/a title to the highlighted text - this can serve as a short summary of an article. On the negative side it is only available for Windows and only stores a certain amount of references per project (per database)	Not ideal for substantial pieces of work; more suitable for secondary school level.
